

Whiteboard Do's & Don'ts

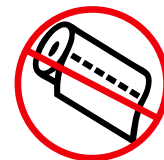
Do's

- ★ Do clean the whiteboard at least once a week
- ★ Do use Microfiber soft cloth as the fibers trap the ink while also polishing the surface
- ★ Do use Dry Erase Markers ONLY
- ★ Do use Isopropyl Alcohol to clean your whiteboard. You can make your own solution by using 50% water 50% Isopropyl Alcohol



Don'ts

- ★ Don't use Sharpies, Permanent Markers or anything other than a Dry Erase Marker
- ★ Don't use a chalk eraser on a whiteboard
- ★ Don't use stickers or tape on your whiteboard
- ★ Don't use Abrasive Cleaners such as Brillo pads that can potentially scratch the boards surface
- ★ Don't leave writing on for too long-even Dry Erase Markers will eventually stain & cause ghosting
- ★ Don't use coarse or granular cloth or paper products



If you follow these tip you will greatly reduce the potential for white board ghosting!
